<p><b>1 Michi no Eki Kyowa</b> [B-2]</p> <p>Stocking a large selection of local products, as well as specialities from Sadowara in Miyazaki due to a friendship city relationship.</p> <p>● November - April: 9:00-18:00          May - October: 9:00-19:00          ▶ 10 minutes by car from Ugo-Sakai Station</p>	<p><b>2 Kurashi no Rekishikan</b> [C-2]</p> <p>Museum documenting the history of local clothing, cuisine and lifestyles with over 4,000 items including immersive recreations of traditional rural life.</p> <p>● Mid-May - early-June          ● Mid-October - mid-November          ● 9:00 - 16:00          ▶ 18 minutes on foot from Mineyoshikawa Station</p>	<p><b>3 Michi no Eki Kamioka</b> [C-2]</p> <p>Stocking regional souvenirs, Kamioka's Akita Komachi rice and local products made with Ajidoraku sauce alongside a restaurant serving fresh local produce.</p> <p>● 9:00-18:00          (April-October Weekends &amp; Holidays: 8:30-18:30)          ▶ 8 minutes by car from Kariwano Station</p>	<p><b>4 AEON MALL Omagari</b> [D-3]</p> <p>Large shopping mall housing 95 shops including fashion, restaurants, services and a cinema.</p> <p>● 9:00-21:00          ▶ 10 minutes by car from Omagari Station</p>	<p><b>5 Koshio Shrine</b> [D-3]</p> <p>Built by the famous shrine builder Jimbei of Hida, the construction is entirely free of nails. It also houses elegant and refined sculptures with Murotsuchi elements embedded throughout.</p> <p>▶ 10 minutes by car from Omagari Station</p>	<p><b>6 Amarume Park</b> [E-3]</p> <p>A local park enjoyed by locals for its cherry blossoms and fireflies. Every April there is a rare opportunity to see fireworks alongside the blossoms at Amarume Sakura Hanabi.</p> <p>▶ 20 minutes by car from Omagari Station</p>	<p><b>7 Kakumagawa - River Port Town</b> [E-3]</p> <p>Centred around the shipping trade on the Omono River, Kakumagawa prospered with one of the highest concentrations of land owners in Akita from Edo to Meiji, and again from Taisho to early Showa. Each season is painted on the variety of trees, and the four metre Yukimi Stone Lantern is a spectacular sight.</p> <p>● Mid-May - mid-November          ● 9:00 - 16:00 (Last entry: 15:30)          ◆ Monday          ★ ¥300          ▶ 10 minutes by car from Omagari Station</p>	<p><b>11 Hotta Branch Gardens</b> [D-4]</p> <p>Situated three kilometres north-east of the Ikeda Family Gardens, the Hotta Branch Gardens at just under half the size also have a boundary reflecting the Hexagonal Chinese Bellflower family crest.</p> <p>● Open outside winter          ▶ 15 minutes by car from Omagari Station</p>	<p><b>12 Hotta no Saku</b> [D-4]</p> <p>Dating back 1,200 years to the early Heian period, the fortification was built to unify the area and functioned as a hub for local government, military and ceremonies.</p> <p>● 9:00 - 16:00          Information Centre: April - November and December - March with a reservation          ▶ 15 minutes by car from Omagari Station</p>	<p><b>13 Mt. Odai</b> [C-5]</p> <p>In winter, Mt. Odai is popular with skiers and snowboarders. Accessible by car in warmer seasons, the lookout offers an excellent view over Daisen.</p> <p>▶ 40 minutes by car from Omagari Station</p>	<p><b>14 Yaotome Park</b> [C-3]</p> <p>Blanketed in over 2,000 cherry trees, Mt. Yaotome was selected as one of the top thirty places in Akita for sakura. Walkways run throughout, making it possible to stroll underneath the blossoms.</p> <p>▶ 5 minutes by car from Ugo-Nagano Station</p>

**15 Karamatsu Shrine** [K-7]  
Visitors from near and far travel to Karamatsu Shrine for its strong ties to fertility and healthy birth, and to touch the stone that is believed to bestow the gift of children.

**16 Chiyo Midori** [K-7]  
The casual but sophisticated brewery is nationally designated as a Tangible Cultural Property, and for generations has been producing high-quality, mellow sake with on-site well water.

**17 Mahoroba Karamatsu** [K-7]  
Mahoroba is Akita's only authentic noh theatre. The background depicting two young pines, grand stage, and dramatic pillars either side leave a powerful impression.

**18 Nakagawara Community Park** [K-8]  
Pleasant spot to relax amongst the calm flow of Omono River backed by the striking Mt. Dake. A fireworks display is held here every year on 14 September.

**19 Kariho** [K-8]  
Since 1865, Kariho has been brewing sake with naturally filtered spring water from the Ou Ranges. With a fine balance of minerals at a medium hardness, it's matched for the yamahai method passed down at the brewery.

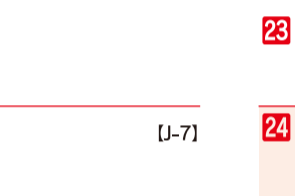
**20 Hozo-ji Giant Zelkova** [K-8]  
Standing in the grounds of Hozo-ji with 11m in circumference, this giant zelkova at 38m high is thought to be over 950 years old, possessing a girth and rate of growth said to be the most impressive in the prefecture.

**21 Hideyoshi** [K-9]  
Hideyoshi was once privately commissioned to brew sake for the lord of Akita and was recognised as outstandingly (hide) good (yoshi), which lead to the brewery's naming.

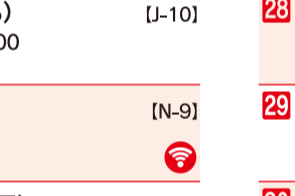
**22 Michi no Eki Nakasen** [K-9]  
Rest area stocking a range of Akita products including local Tochu Tea and Pork. Inside is a noodle shop, restaurant, farmer's market and rice flour bakery section.

**23 Omagari Hanabi**  
Artists representing the peak of Japanese fireworks from all over the country compete for the coveted title at this national fireworks competition dating back to 1910. Every year hanabi artists gather to personally fire their own displays, each team putting forward their proudest work. Fireworks displays are also held in spring, autumn and winter.

**24 Suwa Shrine** [Q-9]  
Omagari Hanabi began as part of Suwa Shrine's annual ceremony. Established in 801, the shrine holds events passing down traditions of old.

Offering tourist information and a large selection of local products with relaxed lounge area. Grand Port stocks a wide range of Hanabi Town fireworks merchandise unique to Daisen.

**Omagari Natto Soup**  
This variation on miso soup is a household favourite of the people of Omagari, usually including wild vegetables, mushrooms, leaf mustard and tofu. Natto (fermented soybean) is ground and blended into the soup giving it a rich texture. Available at the following restaurants — Kitano Suisan, Hana

**Omagari Curry Umen**  
The people of Omagari have been enjoying curry umen for more than 50 years since 1965. Made with ramen noodles and a mentsuyu soup usually found in udon or soba, then topped with curry. Available at the following restaurants — Fuji, Hikari, Hana
